In the circumstances above, the temporary appointments of the above Agricultural Officers are regularised with effect from the dates on which they joined duty, as mentioned above.

They are placed on probation for a period of two years on duty within a continuous period of three years from the date of joining duty.

During the period of probation they should pass Account Test (Lower) for satisfactory completion of probation.

The Principal Agricultural Officers concerned will take necessary steps to declare/extend/terminate the probation of the officers as the case may be.
