To cater to the emerging training needs on plant health management, various training courses are identified to be organized during 2016-17 at NIPHM, Hyderabad.

The Plant health is influenced by several biotic and abiotic factors such as soil, nutrient management, insect pests, diseases, weeds etc. So, there is need to emphasize for synergistic use of complementary management practices to improve soil fertility & plant health. With a view to update the knowledge, skills and management strategies to overcome the stresses that limit plants from achieving their full genetic potential, the below mentioned training courses are designed and offered for agricultural professionals.

Further, it is also informed that


- i. NIPHM will meet the course fee, boarding and lodging charges of the participants nominated by government departments, SAUs/ICAR Institutes.
- ii. Participants will be reimbursed travelling allowances as per their entitlement but restricted to IInd AC train fare on production of the original rail/ bus/ tickets or boarding pass according to the norms of NIPHM.
- iii. However, the Air fare (*Traveled by AirIndia only*) shall be reimbursed to the participants from J& K, North Eastern states and Andman & Nicobar subject to their entitlement. (*Details attached*)
- iv. Local transport from railway/bus station / airport shall be borne by nominating office or trainees.
- v. Accommodation will be available in NIPHM hostel, Rajendranagar Hyderabad 500030 for trainees only. No accommodation shall be provided to the family members or guests of the trainees.
- vi. The NIPHM including hostels and peripheral area are 'No Alcohol Zones' and use or possession of liquor is strictly prohibited.

It is therefore requested that nominated officers should strictly adhere to the above mentioned terms and conditions.


