Sub: Request for nomination in-

1. 21 days training on "Quarantine pests: Detection and identification from 4<sup>th</sup> to 24<sup>th</sup> April, 2017.
2. 5 days training on Quarantine pathogens: Seed Health Testing Methods and Molecular Diagnostic techniques from 17<sup>th</sup> to 21<sup>st</sup> April, 2017.

The Plant Quarantine system is the first line of defense against the introduction and possible establishment of exotic pests. It is essential to identify quarantine pests of concern to India to prevent its introduction and spread. Accurate diagnosis at appropriate time can save the nation from exotic pest incursions. The National Institute of Plant Health Management is premier capacity building institute in the field of Plant Health Management, Biosecurity and Incursion Management and Pesticide Management. The Institute is organizing Quarantine pests: Detection and identification training programme from 4<sup>th</sup> to 24<sup>th</sup> April, in which Seed Health Testing Methods and Molecular Diagnostic techniques training from 17<sup>th</sup> to 21<sup>st</sup> April, 2017 is a module.

The training will enable the participants to identify pathways for pest introduction, domestic and Quarantine fruit fly detection and identification, weed seed identification, seed health testing protocols, stored grain insect detection and identification and Molecular diagnostics.

NIPHM will provide lodging and boarding free of cost and travel assistance for the officers/officials of State Department of Agriculture, SAU's, DPPQ&S and ICAR institutes. Since accommodation is limited, family members of the participants cannot be accommodated. The travel expenses will be reimbursed subject to shortest route from place of posting to NIPHM and back, for the entitled class but restricted to II-tier AC rail fare on the production of original tickets/vouchers. The NIPHM travelling allowance reimbursement guidelines is enclosed along with the invitation letter and the reimbursement of TA claim would be made through online into the participant Saving Bank A/C.
