As we are aware that indiscriminate pesticide usage in agriculture production is becoming an alarming issue across the world which needs to be addressed to protect our environment such as air, soil and water apart from our human health. Judicious use of pesticides is important issue to be addressed and skill development on selection of appropriate application techniques needs to be taken up. After getting a good produce the other important issue is post harvest management and storage techniques. A proper and scientific storage facility is required to safely store in order to mitigate the needs of our increasing population. These training programs emphasis on the above aspects which will be very helpful for enhancing knowledge and skill to the officers and ultimately to the farmers.

In this regard, it is requested to kindly nominate 2-3 officials for each training programme being organized at NIPHM, Hyderabad.

Further, it is also informed that

- i. Free boarding and lodging will be provided for the participants nominated by government departments, SAUs/ICAR Institutes for the training program.
- ii. Participants will be paid to and fro travel fare of journey by rail or bus as per the entitlement, restricted to the maximum of AC II tier train fare of the shortest route. TA will be paid only on the production of original tickets.
- iii. Air fare (travelled by Air India only) shall be reimbursed to the participants from J&K, North Eastern states and Andaman & Nicobar subject to their entitlement and production of original boarding passes.
- iv. Local transport from railway station/ bus stand/ airport to NIPHM shall be borne by NIPHM on production of pre-paid receipt.
- v. No accommodation shall be provided to the family members or guests of the trainees (even on payment basis).
- vi. NIPHM campus including hostels and peripheral areas are "No Alcohol Zones" and use or possession of liquor is strictly prohibited.

It is therefore requested that nominated officers should strictly adhere to the above mentioned terms and conditions.
